Mitigation Efforts: We care deeply about the well-being of our residents and staff, and are doing all we can to limit the potential spread of illness throughout our communities. We are taking extra precautions to mitigate the spread of the virus, which includes supplying employees with appropriate personal protective equipment and following the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid screening measures. Our employees are trained in best practices to prevent the spread of communicable illnesses, including COVID-19.
