1912 – U.S. First Lady Helen (Nellie) Taft and Viscountess Iwa Chinda, wife of the Japanese ambassador, planted the first two cherry trees in Washington, D.C. The trees are Yoshino cherries, and they are still at the south end of 17th Street.

1958 – Nikita Khrushchev became the prime minister of the Soviet Union. An impulsive leader, he became notorious for his saber-rattling rhetoric. Within the Soviet



Union, Khrushchev tried to humanize the system by releasing waves of political prisoners from the Gulag, a network of forced labor camps.

and “We Belong Together.” Her countless accolades include five Grammy Awards and 15 *Billboard* Music Awards, and she was inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame in 2022. Carey has two children, Monroe and Moroccan.
