1882 – At a department store in New York City, employees gave the first public pancake-making demonstration, popularizing the breakfast food.

1901 – Wilhelm Maybach of the Daimler Motor Corporation introduced a 35-horsepower Mercedes automobile at the five-day “Week of Nice” auto show in Nice, France. The Mercedes 35 HP is regarded as the first modern car.



1965 – Civil rights activists led by Martin Luther King Jr. successfully completed their four-day, 50-mile march from Selma to the capitol in Montgomery, Alabama. The focus of their drive was to win voting rights for African Americans in the South.

Happy Birthday!

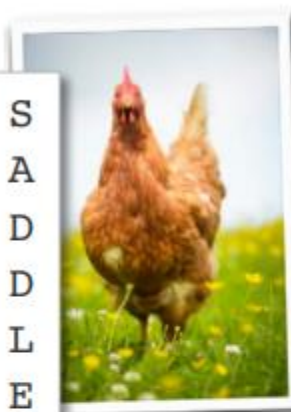
Tom Glavine, born in 1966, is a former Major League Baseball pitcher and a distinguished figure in the sport’s history. Glavine enjoyed a remarkable career, primarily with the Atlanta Braves, and later with the New York Mets, earning his place in baseball’s Hall of Fame. He was known for his precision and control on the mound and his ability to pitch effectively for over two decades. Glavine’s numerous accolades include two Cy Young Awards and 10 All-Star selections. Glavine and his wife, Christine, have five children and live in Johns Creek, Georgia.
